## Federal Projects Obligated in Fiscal Year (FY) 2009

As the state-designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Jackson urbanized area, the Region 2 Planning Commission (R2PC), is responsible for developing and managing a Long Range Transportation Plan, which has a 20-year planning horizon, and a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which is a short-term (4-year) implementation document. The current edition of the TIP includes a listing of the adopted road, highway, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian projects programmed to receive federal and/or state funds in Jackson County during the 2008-2011 Fiscal Years.

The Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) —federal transportation legislation adopted in 2005— requires that *"an Annual Listing of projects, for which federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the categories identified in the Transportation Improvement Program."*

Therefore, in response to the above directive, the R2PC is pleased to provide a listing of all the projects in Jackson County "obligated" during Fiscal Year 2009 (October 1, 2008 - September 30, 2009). The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) defines obligated as the federal government's legal commitment to reimburse the implementing agency for the federal share of a project's eligible costs. Although not all obligated projects were initiated or completed during this fiscal year, they have been approved by the FHWA for reimbursement in FY 2010. Some projects actually constructed in FY 2009 were obligated in previous fiscal years and therefore do not appear on this project listing.

### ***Did you know?***

- The total value of the transportation projects obligated in FY 2009 was \$31,000,048.
- The total value of federal funds expended on those projects was \$23,977,320.

## ARRA: Special Funding Conditions for this Year's Listing

Due to the passage of the "American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA)," commonly known as the federal "stimulus" package, there are more local projects using federal funds reported in 2009 than is typically seen in this listing. The Jackson County Road Commission and the City of Jackson maximized the available federal stimulus funds for transportation improvements by "obligating" five road projects using ARRA funding. The ARRA funding provided up to 100% of the costs of those improvements.
