ITEM 7 MICHIGAN TRAVEL COUNTS

Mr. Lanum informed the committee that MDOT was conducting a random survey to determine travel patterns of residents in the state. This information would be used to update and calibrate the traffic model. He stated that if anyone was called about the survey to assure them it was legitimate and anonymous.

ITEM 9 OTHER BUSINESS

- **MDOT Update** Mr. Lanum informed the committee that the pre-UWP meeting had been held and that performance measures were going to be a part of upcoming responsibilities.

Mr. Gulock stated that the University Region Non-Motorized Plan was almost completed and that there would be two more public hearings in April. The first one is scheduled for April 13th from 4 to 7 PM. He said they would be identifying corridors to promote throughout the region.

Mr. Fortress informed the committee that Spring Arbor has built a new police department and invited members to the Open House on Wednesday, March 25th from 4 to 7 PM.

Mr. Jancek stated that Blackman Township had signed a purchase agreement with Salco Engineering to construct a new building in the Technology Park.

ITEM 10 PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Hopkins presented a proposal to the committee regarding naming the I-94 corridor from Kalamazoo to Ann Arbor the "Innovation Corridor". He has been in discussions with Kalamazoo and Jackson and stated that this designation could generate opportunities to draw innovative companies to locate along the corridor. Legislation is required to make this designation. Mr. Brittain stated that Cascades could also be promoted with this type of signage.
