
Construction and De-construction Cluster Analysis







National Location Quotient



Change in Location Quotient 2003-2007






Construction State LQ Chart




Regional Location Quotient Distribution




Change in Regional Location Quotient Distribution 2002-2008








Engineering Technology and Design Cluster Analysis







National Location Quotient



Change in Location Quotient 2003-2007








Regional Location Quotient Distribution




Change in Regional Location Quotient Distribution 2002-2008






National Location Quotient



Change in Location Quotient 2003-2007






Mining State LQ Chart




Regional Location Quotient Distribution




Change in Regional Location Quotient Distribution 2002-2008






National Location Quotient



Change in Location Quotient 2003-2007






50 State Location Quotient Distribution

Supply Chain and Logistics State LQ Chart




Regional Location Quotient Distribution




Change in Regional Location Quotient Distribution 2002-2008




