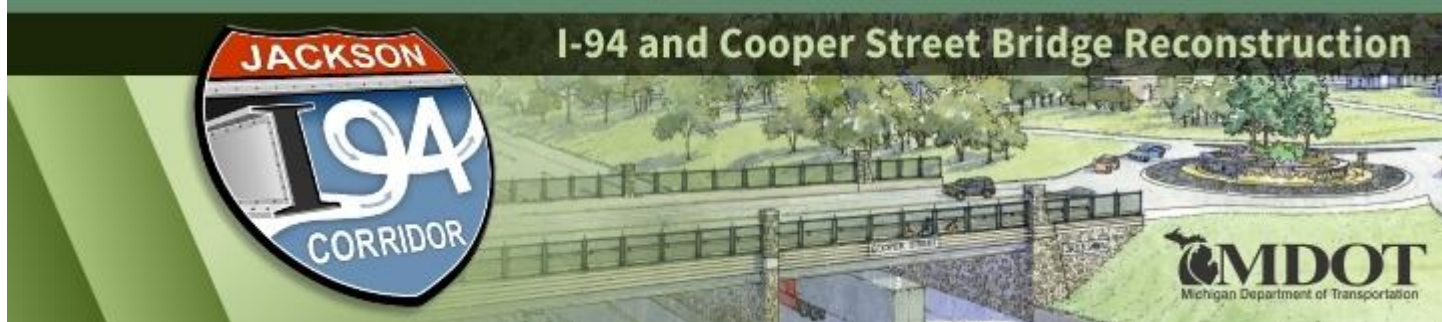

I-94 Project Update

April 8, 2019 – Work on the new eastbound I-94 bridge over the Grand River continues. The contractor will be placing beams for the remaining spans, as well as continue work on the new bridge deck. Starting this weekend, the contractor will begin demolition work on the existing Cooper Street bridge.

Along the eastbound I-94 Cooper Street off ramp, crews will be finishing up mine grouting to fill voids below the I-94/ Cooper Street interchange throughout the week. Additionally, crews will continue the removal process of the existing facilities and placing embankment within the closure limits of the Cooper Street interchange. The rehabilitation work on Cooper Street from Ganson St to Porter St and the placement of right of way fence along the project limits will continue.

Continuing this week, single lane closures will be performed at night on I-94 eastbound with all lanes open to traffic each morning, as well as daytime single lane closures on Cooper Street from Ganson St to Porter St. Daytime shoulder closures and reduced speed zones along eastbound I-94 between Lansing Avenue and Elm Road near Cooper Street will remain in place to delineate the work zone. Cooper Street over I-94 remains closed until September and the eastbound I-94 Cooper Street off ramp remains closed until early-June.

ATTENTION: I-94 will be closed this Friday, Saturday, and Sunday evenings to accommodate the removal of the existing Cooper Street bridge over I-94. Eastbound I-94 will be maintained with a single lane closure utilizing the existing Cooper Street off and on ramps, and westbound I-94 will utilize the posted detour route for the above freeway closure.

When Cooper street reopens the interchange layout will be significantly different. The new interchange layout will consist of two new roundabouts.
