Michigan Avenue | Chapel Road Sidepath

Provide pathway connection between Spring Arbor, Parma and Western School Campus following right-of-way of Michigan Avenue and Chapel Road. May need to use private property adjacent to roadway to avoid topography and vegetation.

Length

5.8 miles

Public Input

There was strong desire by some to use Dearing Road as the main connection. After further review of the corridor and other public input, Chapel Road seems to be the more feasible option; cutting through neighborhood roads in Spring Arbor was not supported due to private roads and property owners.

Need to work around swales

Road Crossings

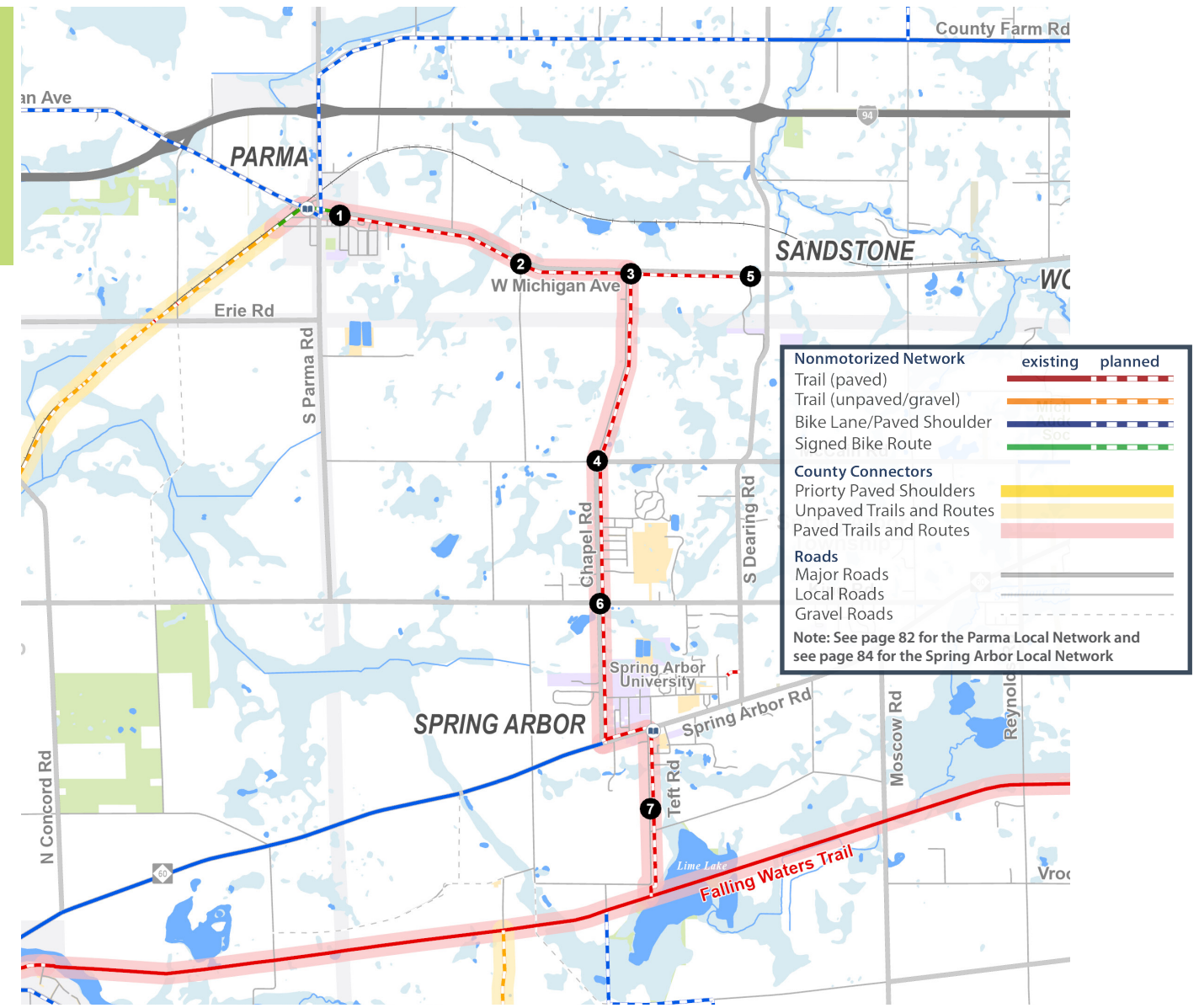

- 2 Marked crosswalk at S Harrington Road
- 3 Marked crosswalk at Chapel Road
- 4 Marked crosswalk at McCain Road
- 5 Connection to Western High School Campus
- 6 Marked crosswalk at King Road
- 7 Pathway along Teft Road under development
