Earlier this month, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) released updated allocations to the CMAQ program for Fiscal Years (FY) 2023, 2024, 2025 and 2026. Cumulatively, CMAQ funding was reduced by \$2,500,000 per year across the state, and by \$93,673 in Lenawee County in FY 2023. A more detailed breakdown for FY 2023 is shown in the following table:

<b>Previous Lenawee County FY23 CMAQ Allocation</b>	<b>Reduction in Lenawee County FY23 CMAQ Allocation</b>	<b>New Lenawee County FY23 CMAQ Allocation</b>
\$206,000	\$93,673	<b>\$112,327</b>

MDOT estimates the CMAQ allocations will increase by 2% per year. The allocations for FYs 2023, 2024, 2025 and 2026 are estimated to be as shown in the following table:

<b>FY 2024</b>	<b>\$114,574</b>
<b>FY 2025</b>	<b>\$116,865</b>
<b>FY 2026</b>	<b>\$119,202</b>

Due to the decrease in Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 CMAQ funding, R2PC staff requests the Lenawee County CMAQ Committee reduce the amount of programmed funding to FY 2023 projects to the new targets. Currently, there are two projects programmed that cumulatively total \$210,294 in federal funding. The anticipated CMAQ allocation and amount over-programmed at the new targets is shown below:
