

ITEM 4 **AGENCY STATUS REPORTS**

Project status updates were presented by the City of Jackson, Jackson Area Transportation Authority, Jackson County Department of Transportation, the Michigan Department of Transportation, and The Enterprise Group. The following project details were provided:

- City of Jackson –The Steward Street project was let on June 7. The bridge preventative maintenance project will start on June 14 and be completed by the end of July. The Elmdale Trail bridge is scheduled to be delivered by June 23.
- Jackson Area Transportation Authority – New busses that have been ordered will arrive in 2022. The project to install new fences and gates started on June 1.
- Jackson County Department of Transportation – The McCain Road and Robinson Road projects will be let in July. The South Jackson Road intersection realignment project will begin in August. The crush and shape project for the Village of Grass Lake will be delayed until July 4 upon the request of the Village. Once it begins, it is expected to be completed by August 20, weather permitting.
- Michigan Department of Transportation – The poles for the permanent message boards along I-94 and US-127 have been installed. Lansing Avenue will be closed at the end of June.
- The Enterprise Group – The County Farm project has been approved by the EDA. A public meeting will be held at Northwest High School in the beginning of July to provide information on the project.



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ITEM 3 APPROVE MINUTES OF THE POLICY COMMITTEE MEETING OF MAY 20, 2021 AND RECEIVE THE TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES OF MAY 19, 2021

A motion was made by Vice Chair Jancek, supported by Mr. Purvis, to approve the Policy Committee meeting minutes of May 20, 2021 and receive the Technical Advisory Committee meeting minutes of May 19, 2021 as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

ITEM 4 AGENCY STATUS REPORTS

Project status updates were presented by the City of Jackson, Jackson Area Transportation Authority, Jackson County Department of Transportation, Michigan Department of Transportation, Jackson County Airport-Reynolds Field, and The Enterprise Group. The following project details were provided:

- City of Jackson – The Morrell project preconstruction meeting was held on June 16, and work on the project will begin July 6. The bridge preventative maintenance project began on June 14. The Elmdale Trail bridge will be delivered June 23, and the project should be completed by July 4. Wright Electric was the low bidder and awarded the Wisner Street traffic signal project.
- Jackson Area Transportation Authority – Only two bids were received for the project to have new concrete for the parking area and driveways installed at the JATA Transfer Center. The project may have to be rebid. Another driver has been hired for the Rides to Wellness program.
- Jackson County Department of Transportation – The Jefferson Road and West Michigan Avenue tree removal project has been completed. The South Jackson Road intersection realignment project will begin in August. The edge line pavement marking project came in at 47% under the engineer estimate.
- Michigan Department of Transportation – The pavement marking project has begun, and much of the work has been completed. Work on the Lansing Avenue bridge has been pushed back to the end of June. The poles for the permanent message boards along I-94 and US-127 have been installed.
- Jackson County Airport-Reynolds Field – The purchase of a snow removal truck is being considered. A truck in Houghton, Michigan has come available, and the airport will be bidding on it. 90% of the cost would be reimbursed through federal funding, and 5% would be reimbursed through state funding. The remaining 5% of the cost would be provided as a local match by the county.
- The Enterprise Group – The County Farm project has been approved for funding by the EDA. There will be a public meeting at Northwest High School in the beginning of July. The award amount is just under \$7 million dollars.

The employment data that is used in the model is being reviewed by The Enterprise Group.

2021

Morrell Street: Greenwood to Martin Luther King Jr Dr (Urban) – Reconstruct pavement with curb repairs. HRC is the City's consultant on this project. **The water main project is complete. The Street work is scheduled to start July 7, 2021.**

Steward Street: RR to Ganson (Urban) – Mill and asphalt resurface with curb repairs and signal reconstruction at Ganson. HRC is the City's consultant on this project. Project was let by MDOT on June 7 with J Ranck as the low bidder. The Project will be on the City Council July 13 meeting for the street assessment and MDOT contract approval.

Bridge CPM (BHT) Denton, Mechanic, North and Trail - Rehabilitation on the four bridges. Great Lakes Engineering is the City's consultant on this project. **Project started on June 14 and is scheduled to be completed by July 24.**

Elmdale Trail: Hickory to South St (SR2S) - Reconstruction of the existing path to a 10' wide concrete non-motorized path. Rowe Professional Services is the City's consultant on this project. **Bridge has been installed and the concrete deck has been poured and is curing. The remaining part of the concrete path will be placed after the wing walls are backfilled.**

Wisner St Traffic Signals (HSIP) Ganson, North and Argyle - Replacement of the existing traffic signals at these three intersections with mast arm signals. HRC is the City's consultant on this project. **Project was awarded to Wright Electric. Preconstruction meeting will be scheduled soon.**

2022

E. High Street Bridge over the Grand River - Replacement of the existing bridge superstructure. HRC is the City's consultant on this project. **Plans and estimate for the GI have been delivered to MDOT. GI date has not been scheduled yet.**

West Avenue Signals at Franklin and Washington - Reconstruct Signal and intersection at Franklin and West Ave. HRC is the City's consultant on this project. Utility coordination meeting was held on May 5 to get power, phone and cable wires raised above 23 feet.

2022 (continued)

West/Morrell Signal and Ganson/Elm Signal – Replace the Signals with Safety Funds. HRC is the City's consultant on this project. Utility coordination meeting was held on May 5 to get power, phone and cable wires raised above 23 feet.

Greenwood Ave: Fourth St to Morrell St (Urban) - Mill and HMA Resurface HRC is Selected as the City's consultant on this project.

Greenwood/Fourth & Fourth/Prospect Signal – Replace the signals with HIP Covid Funds. HRC is the City's consultant on this project. City Council adopted the resolution to use the HIP Covid Funds for these signal projects on May 11.

We would like to provide the following update regarding our projects that are on the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2020 and 2021.

FY 2020

JN 207225/207226 Jefferson Road and W Michigan Ave tree removal

Project was completed in mid-June.

JN 207227 S Jackson Road intersection re-alignment

Work will begin in late-July, with anticipated completion in August.

JN 206577 S Union Street (Village of Parma)

Project has been awarded. Work will begin in August.

FY 2021

JN 206636 Preventative Maintenance, Countywide

This project was submitted to MDOT for a GI Meeting.

JN 207171 McCain Road and Robinson Road

Project documents were submitted for a July letting. Work will begin in Fall of 2021.

JN 210386 Edge line pavement marking

Project was let in June, and a Contractor was selected. Work will begin in late-Summer or Fall of 2021.

JN 210343 South Dearing Road and McCain Road mini-roundabout

This project was be submitted to MDOT for a GI meeting. Construction is scheduled for summer of 2022 in order to minimize disruptions to traffic for Western Schools.

JN 210356 Village of Grass Lake

Crush and shape and resurface project began on July 5th. Project completion is middle of August.

County Farm/Springport Corridor Improvements and Jackson Technology Park – North Construction

Public Meeting took place on June 30. Project documents will be submitted for a GI review in late-July or early-August. Anticipated start date is early 2022.

I-94 & US-127 – Install cameras and/or permanent message boards near Airport Road, Parnall Road, Page Ave, I-94/US-127 south interchange, Hawkins Road, Whipple Road, and Grass Lake Scales. Poles installed.

I-94 at Elm Road, Lansing Ave. and West Ave (US-127 west), also includes resurfacing on US-127 (I-94 to Parnall) – Traffic shifted on I-94 near West Ave for median construction. Pouring concrete for new WB I-94 near West Ave. Lansing Ave bridge construction underway.

Jackson TSC wide trunkline crack sealing – Various routes. Work began in June

Jackson TSC wide pavement marking – Various routes. Work began in June.

US-127 from Ayers to Liberty – Maintenance funded resurfacing. Work begins in August.

I-94 BL (Michigan Ave) near Henry Ford Allegiance – Install pedestrian refuge island and rapid reflective flashing beacon. Work begins in the fall.

US-127 bridges over M-50/Railroad (just north of McDevitt) – Deck replacement and superstructure repairs. Construction on US-127 median for maintaining traffic starts in the fall. Bridge work in spring of 2022.

Railroad bridges over Jackson Street and Mechanic Street in downtown Jackson – Bridge replacement (late 2021/early 2022 construction).

1. The Jackson Area Transportation Authority (JATA) is requesting the Region 2 Planning Commission to approve a project change in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) project job number 207685. This project is for FY2021 Section 5307 – CTF Urbanized Formula (Operating). It is currently programmed in the TIP for \$1,300,000 (federal only). JATA would like to request a modification in the cost, if allowable, to \$1,315,859 for the Federal portion of the TIP. With a local match from the State of Michigan in CFT Funding for the amount of \$1,717,224 this would bring the Total Project Cost to \$3,033,083. This figure was attained from the federal apportionments letter received January 27, 2021. The table below shows the specific project information JATA would like to have modified.
