ITEM 1 CALL TO ORDER

Chair Shotwell called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM.

ITEM 2 PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments received.

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| TEM 3 | APPROVE MINUTES OF THE POLICY COMMITTEE MEETING OF | MAY 20, 2021 AND RECEIVE THE TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES OF MAY 19, 2021

A motion was made by Vice Chair Jancek, supported by Mr. Purvis, to approve the Policy Committee meeting minutes of May 20, 2021 and receive the Technical Advisory Committee meeting minutes of May 19, 2021 as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

ITEM 4 AGENCY STATUS REPORTS

Project status updates were presented by the City of Jackson, Jackson Area Transportation Authority, Jackson County Department of Transportation, Michigan Department of Transportation, Jackson County Airport-Reynolds Field, and The Enterprise Group. The following project details were provided:

- <u>City of Jackson</u> The Morrell project preconstruction meeting was held on June 16, and work on the
 project will begin July 6. The bridge preventative maintenance project began on June 14. The
 Elmdale Trail bridge will be delivered June 23, and the project should be completed by July 4. Wright
 Electric was the low bidder and awarded the Wisner Street traffic signal project.
- <u>Jackson Area Transportation Authority</u> Only two bids were received for the project to have new
 concrete for the parking area and driveways installed at the JATA Transfer Center. The project may
 have to be rebid. Another driver has been hired for the Rides to Wellness program.
- <u>Jackson County Department of Transportation</u> The Jefferson Road and West Michigan Avenue tree removal project has been completed. The South Jackson Road intersection realignment project will begin in August. The edge line pavement marking project came in at 47% under the engineer estimate.
- <u>Michigan Department of Transportation</u> The pavement marking project has begun, and much of the
 work has been completed. Work on the Lansing Avenue bridge has been pushed back to the end of
 June. The poles for the permanent message boards along I-94 and US-127 have been installed.
- <u>Jackson County Airport-Reynolds Field</u> The purchase of a snow removal truck is being considered.
 A truck in Houghton, Michigan has come available, and the airport will be bidding on it. 90% of the cost would be reimbursed through federal funding, and 5% would be reimbursed through state funding. The remaining 5% of the cost would be provided as a local match by the county.
- <u>The Enterprise Group</u> The County Farm project has been approved for funding by the EDA. There will be a public meeting at Northwest High School in the beginning of July. The award amount is just under \$7 million dollars.

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ITEM 5 APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE JACTS FY 2020-2023 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

Ms. Kline reported that JCDOT was requesting the following amendment to the JACTS FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP):

A motion was made by Vice-Chair Jancek, supported by Mr. Trudell, to receive the project from JCDOT as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

ITEM 6 OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Duke noted that the JACTS Policy Committee meetings will remain virtual at this time. The City of Jackson City Council is still meeting virtually and virtual meetings are still allowed by the City of Jackson Resolution Number 2021-17.

Ms. DeOliveira shared that there will be a memo requesting Township, Village, and City officials review the 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan total household and total population data that is used in the Travel Demand Model. The Travel Demand Model is used to predict future deficiencies within the transportation system in Jackson County. The employment data that is used in the model is being reviewed by The Enterprise Group.
