## ITEM 5B APPROVAL OF RURAL TASK FORCE (RTF) PROJECTS TO THE VILLAGE OF BROOKLYN

Mr. Schauerte brought forward two Village of Brooklyn projects, approved by Full RTF on 2/25/2022, and three JATA projects, approved by Full RTF on 1/13/2022.

A motion was made by Mr. Franklin, supported by Mr. Feldvary, to approve the Rural Task Force projects in the village of Brooklyn and for JATA. The motion carried with 5 in favor, 3 opposed, 4 abstain.

#### ITEM 6 OTHER BUSINESS

Ms. Kline brought forward six projects and that were approved by the JACTS TIP-Subcommittee to utilize additional available funding from STP, STP-Flex, and Carbon Reduction at the subcommittee meeting on March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The six projects are, 1) FY 22 – JCDOT – Pavement Markings – Location TBD - \$193,389 Federal; 2) FY 22 – City of Jackson – Traffic Signal at Greenwood/High St. - \$193,389 Federal; 3) FY 23 – JCDOT – Signal Replacement - \$351,000 Federal; 4) FY 24 – City of Jackson – MLK Equality Trail Phase 1 - \$375,000 Federal; 5) FY 25 – City of Jackson – MLK Equality Trail Phase 2 - \$384,000 Federal; 6) JCDOT – Signal Modernization – Location TBD–\$393,000 Federal. A motion was made by Chair Shotwell, supported by Mr. Jancek, to approve these TIP-Subcommittee projects. The motion carried unanimously.
