1. **CALL TO ORDER**

Vice Chair Dowling called the meeting to order at 9:31 AM.

2. **PUBLIC COMMENT**

No public comments were received.

3. **APPROVAL OF 5/18/22 TAC MEETING MINUTES AND RECEIVAL OF 5/19/22 POLICY COMMITTEE MINUTES**

A motion was made by Mr. Ripstra, supported by Mr. Taylor, to approve the 5/18/22 TAC meeting minutes and to receive the 5/19/22 Policy Committee meeting minutes, as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

4.A. **AGENCY STATUS REPORTS**

Project status updates were presented by the City of Jackson, Jackson County Department of Transportation, Jackson Area Transportation Authority, the Michigan Department of Transportation and Enterprise Group.

4.B. **DRAFT SOCIO-ECONOMIC FORECASTS**

Mr. Schauerte alerted the committee that in preparation for the development of the Transportation Demand Model (TPM) for the 2050 Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), MDOT is requesting the local agencies review the 2025-2050 forecasts that were provided for households, employment and population. Comments should be submitted prior to the July JACTS meeting. MDOT has requested that the committee approve the socio-economic data at the July JACTS meetings.

5.A. **APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE FY 2020-2023 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)**

The following amendments to the JACTS FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) were submitted by the Jackson Area Transportation Authority:

1. JN 2107691 - FY 2022 – Section 5307 Operating – Operating Assistance - \$1,300,000 Federal; \$1,300,000 State; \$2,600,000 Total - (*\*Update to \$1,692,518 Federal; \$1,592,451 State; \$3,284,969 Total*)

A motion was made by Mr. White, supported by Mr. Taylor, to approve the amendments to the FY 2020-2023 TIP, as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

5.B. **APPROVAL OF THE FY 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)**

Mr. Schauerte provided an overview of the changes to the document, project list and consultation list that had occurred since the May JACTS meeting. Mr. Schauerte also informed the committee of a public comment received from the Active Jackson Coalition after the packet had been published. Mr. Schauerte stated the comment and alerted the committee that it would be included in the appendix of the document.

A motion was made by Mr. Smith, supported by Mr. Ripstra, to approve the Fiscal Year 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program. The motion carried unanimously.
