The following amendments to the JACTS FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) were submitted by the Jackson Area Transportation Authority and Michigan Department of Transportation:

- 1. JATA JN TBD FY 2022 Section 5339 Bus & Bus Facilities Admin/Maint. Facility Improvements – New Project - \$105,350 Federal; \$26,338 State; \$131,688 Total
- 2. MDOT JN 216828 FY 2022 Amtrak Tie and Surface Program SOGR Fund Source – (\*Update to \$0 Federal; \$5,880,002 State; \$5,880,002 Total)
- 3. MDOT JN 211081 FY 2022 I-94 W Hot-Mix Asphalt Mill & 1 Course Overlay on Lanes and Median Shoulder & Chip/Fog on Out Shoulder – IM Fund Source - \$1,653,558 Federal; \$183,729 State; \$1,837,286 Total - (\*Update to \$2,457,090 Federal; \$273,010 State; \$2,730,100 Total)

**SUBJECT:** TIP Project Status

#### 2021

<u>Steward Street: RR to Ganson (Urban)</u> – Mill and asphalt resurface with curb repairs and signal reconstruction at Ganson. All surface and subsurface work is complete. **Delivery** of signal poles and mast arms is confirmed for the first week of July 2022. Installation is scheduled for the week of July 11, 2022.

<u>Wisner St Traffic Signals (HSIP) Ganson, North and Argyle</u> – Replacement of the existing traffic signals at these three intersections with mast arm signals. **All poles, arms, signal** heads and associated conduits, conductors and controllers are installed. Currently awaiting Consumer's service connection.

#### <u>2022</u>

- <u>E. High Street Bridge over the Grand River</u> Replacement of the existing bridge superstructure. **Steel beam delivery is confirmed for July 11 and 12.**
- <u>West Avenue Signals at Franklin, Washington and Morrell with Ganson and Elm Signal</u> -Reconstruct Signals on West Ave at Franklin and Morrell with Signal at Ganson and Elm. Contractor is Wright Electric Co. **Water main work is complete. Removals are currently in process. Signal pole foundation installations will commence immediately after removals are complete.**
- <u>Greenwood Ave: Fourth St to Morrell St with Greenwood/Fourth & Fourth/Prospect Signals</u> -Mill and HMA Resurface on Greenwood with signal replacements at the intersections. Contractor is Michigan Paving and Materials Co. **Sidewalk repairs and ramp upgrades** on the east side of Greenwood are complete. Signal pole foundations at Griswold intersection and Fourth and Prospect intersection have been installed. Milling on the east half of Greenwood is scheduled for July 7<sup>th</sup>. The milled surface will be repaved with a single course of HMA shortly thereafter.

#### <u>2023</u>

- <u>Brown Street: Morrell to Michigan Mill</u> and repave, relocate curb and construct nonmotorized trail on east side. Spaulding DeDecker is the consultant on this project.
- <u>Wildwood Avenue: West Ave to Steward</u> Mill and HMA Resurface. Spaulding DeDecker is the consultant on this project.

<u>Crosswalk Enhancements at 5 Locations (HSIP)</u> – Sidewalk ramps, LED bordered signs, along non-motorized paths. HRC is the consultant on this project.
