Resolution to Approve the 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan for the Jackson Area Comprehensive Transportation Study

Whereas, The Jackson Area Comprehensive Transportation Study (JACTS) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Jackson, Michigan urban area; and

Whereas, the development of a long range transportation plan is a requirement of the Federal Highways Administration and the Federal Transit Administration; and

Whereas, the JACTS 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan has been developed pursuant to the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), the federal transportation legislation, with a planning horizon of at least 20 years; and

Whereas, the JACTS 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan identifies transportation facilities that should function as an integrated metropolitan transportation system; and


Whereas, the JACTS 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan includes a financial analysis that demonstrates fiscal prudence, and the resources reasonably expected to carry out the LRTP; and

Whereas, the JACTS 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan was developed through a process that included input from the public, affected public agencies and other interested parties, and

Whereas, the JACTS 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan can be amended periodically upon request with appropriate documentation to support such a request.

Now therefore be it resolved, that the MPO committees of the Jackson Area Comprehensive Transportation Study find the JACTS 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan to be IIJA compliant and approve its submission to the Michigan Department of Transportation for consideration by the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration.
