2022

Greenwood at High Signal - Signal replacement with new mast arm signal. HRC is the consultant on the project. J Ranck Electric is the contractor. **Pole fabrication started the first week of December, after fabrication they need galvanizing and painting. Anticipating the poles will be installed in spring 2024.**

West Avenue Signals at Franklin, Washington and Morrell with Ganson and Elm Signal - Reconstruct Signals on West Ave at Franklin and Morrell with Signal at Ganson and Elm. Contractor is Wright Electric Co.

- a. At West and Franklin, **Project is complete.**
- b. At West and Morrell, the relocation of AT&T aerial wires to underground is next task on critical path. **AT&T has installed the underground conduit on Morrell and pulled the wires splicing needs to be completed and removal of old cables prior to finishing the signals. Speed radar detectors and signs are complete.**

2024

Elm Avenue: North to Floral – Pavement Replacement and sidewalk and ramp repairs. Rowe Professional Services is consulting on this project. **Project is all approved for obligation and is waiting for letting.**

High Street: Executive to South – Crush and shape existing HMA material and repave with two courses of HMA. Rowe Professional Services is consulting on this project. **Project is all approved for obligation and is waiting for letting.**

Lansing Avenue Corridor Safety Enhancements (North) – Enhance existing box span signal at Lansing-Ganson intersection, realign and reconstruct Lansing-Steward intersection, modernize signals to box span at Jackson-Ganson and Lansing-North intersections. Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC) is consulting on this project. **Project is all approved for obligation and is waiting for letting.**

Lansing Avenue Corridor Safety Enhancements (South) – Modernize signals to box span at Lansing-Clinton and Lansing-Monroe intersections and install ped warning signing at Lansing-Backus and Clinton-Monroe intersections. Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC) is consulting on this project. **Project is all approved for obligation and is waiting for letting.**

MLK Equality Trail, Prospect to MLK Jr Drive - Reconstruct trail with 12' wide concrete pavement. Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC) is consulting on this project. **Project is all approved for obligation and is waiting for letting.**

2025

Lansing Avenue: Steward to Clinton – Reconstruct roadway with reduction from four lanes to three and realignment of Lansing-Clinton intersection. Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC) is consulting on this project. The project is currently in design.

Martin Luther King Jr. Dr.: South St to Morrell – Reconstruct roadway with reduction from three lanes to two lanes with parking on both sides and multi-use path on west side. **Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC) is consulting on this project. The project is currently in design.**

MLK Equality Trail, MLK Jr Drive to Merriman with Connector to Elmdale Trail – Reconstruct trail with 12' wide concrete pavement and construct connector to Ella Sharp Park Elmdale Trail. Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC) is consulting on this project. The project is currently in design.

High St, Losey Ave and Morrell St bridges over the Grand River – Capital Preventive Maintenance work on the three bridges. **Great Lakes Engineering is consulting on this project. The project is currently in design.**

We would like to provide the following update regarding our projects that are on the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2022, 2023, and 2024.

Fiscal Year 2022

U.S. Economic Development Administration (EDA) Grant Project

County Farm/Springport Corridor Improvements and Jackson Technology Park North Construction

- Drainage work and paving completed on County Farm Road. Contractor working on slope restoration and pavement markings. Project is currently 90% completed. Sidewalk will be completed once Comcast removes fiber and signals will finish once mast arms arrive in January/February.
- County Farm Road is open to traffic.

HRRR & HSIP Funding – MDOT Safety Grant Projects

Construction:

I-94 at Elm Road, Lansing Ave. and West Ave. (US-127) reconstruction, also includes resurfacing on US-127 (I-94 to Parnall) – Clean up, signing, turf establishment and other various items of work remain.

I-94 from M-60 to Calhoun County line – Reconstruction from M-60 to Michigan Ave, major rehabilitation from Michigan Ave to Calhoun County line – (2022-2025 construction). The contractor continues to build the new median concrete barrier wall and move the temporary concrete barrier. The final traffic shift and pavement markings is expected by December 15th.

Railroad bridges over Jackson Street and Mechanic Street in downtown Jackson – Bridge replacements. The project is substantially complete.

Cooper Street (M-106) signing upgrade from near Michigan Ave to the Jackson/Ingham County line – Construction to occur from October 2023 until March 2024.

Cooper (M-50/US-127BR) over abandoned RR, north of High and south of Morrell – Preventative maintenance bridge repairs. 2024 construction.

Traffic signal modernization on Cooper Street and MLK (Washington, Glick, Ganson, Leroy, Parnall, South, Morrell, & High. MLK at Ganson.) – Work should begin in late 2023.

Martin Luther King Jr. Drive (Old M-106) from Louis Glick to Cooper – Preventative maintenance resurfacing and sidewalk ramps. 2024 construction.

M-50 from East of Clinton Way to M-99 – Preventative maintenance chip seal with fog seal. 2024 construction.

US-127 Freeway Signing Upgrade (Floyd Ave to I-94) – Work underway and will continue into 2024.

Cooper Street (M-106) bridge replacement in downtown Jackson south of train station and Louis Glick (I-94BL) deck replacement near Mechanic Street – 2024/2025 Construction.

Design:

US-127 northbound ramp to Westbound I-94 – Safety project. High friction surface treatment. 2025 Construction.

US-127 Freeway Signing Upgrade (Parnall to Ingham County Line and M-50 to I-94) – 2025 Construction.

US-127 at Jefferson Road – Bridge repairs. 2025 Construction.

US-127 (Henry to near Ingham Co Line) – Maintenance resurfacing and bridge repairs at Huntoon Creek, Berry Road, Grand River and Territorial Road bridges. 2025 construction.

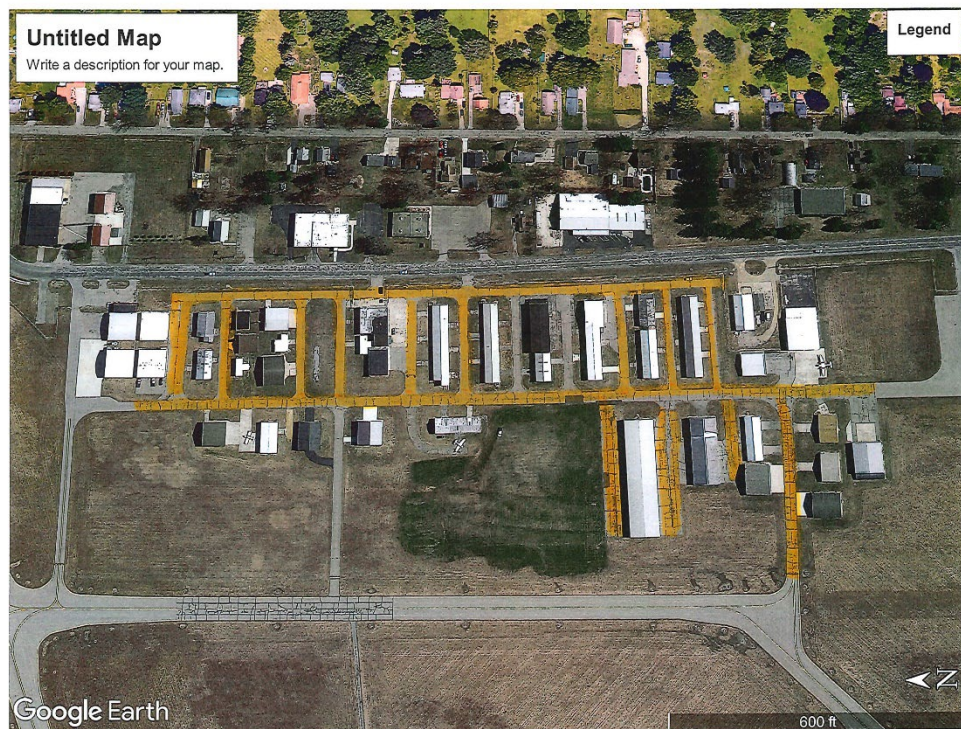

JACTS Airport Update December 2023

- The air traffic control tower project is projected to start on January 18, 2024 and to be completed by December 26, 2024.
- The bid period for the airport water main and hangar area utility improvements is open until December 21. This project will provide storm water management improvements to include storm sewer and detention basins.
- Airport is gathering quotes for rehab of taxi streets on the east side of the airport (see diagram below). These taxi streets received a 2" overlay back in the early 1990's. Taxi streets will be milled and receive an asphalt overlay. Taxi streets are designed for small general aviation aircraft under 5,000 pounds.
- Veregy will commence installing LED retrofit bulbs in the terminal and airport administration buildings on December 19th.

This letter is sent by the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) to inform the Jackson Area Comprehensive Transportation Study committee of Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) amendments to the FY 2023-2026 TIP.

Proposed TIP Amendments:

For the Capital Preventative Maintenance Program-

- 1) The engineering and construction phase for HMA crack sealing on various routes in the Jackson Transportation Service Area are being added to the TIP.

For the Highway Safety Program-

- 2) The engineering and construction phase to widening the shoulder and full of HMA paving on M-50 (Napolean Road to Stony Lake Creek Road) are being added to the TIP.
- 3) The engineering and construction phase to install enhanced delineation on US 127 (from Ohio State Line to Floyd Avenue) are being added to the TIP.
- 4) The engineering phase to install recessing special markings at intersections on various routes in Lenawee County is being added to the TIP.
- 5) The engineering phase to install recessing special markings at intersections on various routes in Jackson County is being added to the TIP.

JACKSON AREA COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION STUDY (JACTS)

Federal Funds Obligated in Fiscal Year 2023

As the state-designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Jackson urbanized area, the Region 2 Planning Commission, is responsible for developing and managing a 20-year Long Range Transportation Plan and a short-term, 4-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The current edition of the TIP includes a listing of the approved road, highway, bridge, transit, and non-motorized projects programmed to receive federal and/or state funds in Jackson County during the 2023-2026 Fiscal Years.

The Federal legislation that was adopted in December 2015, Fixing American's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act), continues the requirement of past legislation that "an Annual Listing of projects, for which federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the categories identified in the Transportation Improvement Program." This was further enhanced by subsequent bills, including the recently passed Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) of 2021.

In response to the above directive, the R2PC is providing a listing of all the projects in Jackson County "obligated" during FY 2023 (October 1, 2022 - September 30, 2023). The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) defines obligated as the federal government's legal commitment to reimburse the implementing agency for the federal share of a project's eligible costs. Although not all obligated projects were initiated or completed during this fiscal year, they have been approved by the FHWA for reimbursement in FY 2023. Some projects actually constructed in FY 2023 were obligated in previous fiscal years and will not appear on this listing.
