#### ITEM 1 CALL TO ORDER AND PUBLIC COMMENT

Chair Kline called the meeting to order at 10:06 AM.

#### ITEM 2 INTRODUCTIONS

Introductions were made.

#### ITEM 3 RURAL TASK FORCE UPDATES

No one from MDOT was present, so no updates were provided.

#### <u>ITEM 4</u> <u>APPROVAL OF MAY 25, 2021, MEETING MINUTES</u>

A motion was made by Mr. Guetschow, supported by Chair Kline, to approve the May 25, 2021 meeting minutes. The motion was approved unanimously.

## ITEM 5 REVIEW OF FY2022 RURAL-STP / TEDF-D TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) PROJECTS AND FUNDING LEVELS

Mr. Acker asked why JATA is eligible to receive RTF funding. It was noted that funding was for capital projects only. Mr. Smith brought documentation that shows dial-a-ride ridership summaries for Zone 3 (i.e., townships outside of the City of Jackson and the Townships of Blackman, Leoni, and Summit): 1,082 trips in 2019, 748 trips in 2020, and 825 trips (as of November 5<sup>th</sup>) in 2021.

The STP funds available for FY 2022 were reduced by 10% and the Village of Brooklyn wanted to add a project. Consequently, the following motions were made:

Chair Kline made a motion, supported by Mr. Guetschow, programming \$100,000 in 2022 STP funds to JATA for "transit (JN 206173)", reducing the amount programed for JCDOTs "various road (JN 206173)" to \$790,420.65 in STP funds (with the understanding that the lost \$33,801.35 be allocated to JCDOT if the funding is restored) and allocating \$135,859 in State-D funds to the project. The motion was approved unanimously.

Mr. Guetschow made a motion, supported by Mr. Smith, to program \$90,778 in 2022 STP funds to the Village of Brooklyn for its Mill Street (N. Main to E. Village Limits) project. The motion was approved unanimously.

Chair Kline made a motion, supported by Mr. Guetschow, to adjust the local match for JCDOTs "various road (JN 206173)" project to \$70,196.50. The motion was approved unanimously.

### ITEM 6 REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF FY 2023-2026 RURAL-STP / TEDF-D PROJECTS

Chair Kline motioned the following for FY 2023, supported by Mr. Smith:

- JCDOT, Various Roads (JN206639): \$900,493 in STP funds, \$130,000 in STATE-D funds, and a \$95,123.25 local match.
- Village of Brooklyn, Constitution Street (S. Main to Tiffany): \$118,507 in STP funds and a \$29,626 local match.

The motion was approved unanimously.

Chair Kline motioned the following for FY 2024-2026, supported by Mr. Guetschow:

- 2024
  - JATA, purchase two vehicles: \$104,000 in STP funds and a \$26,000 local match, for a total of \$130,000
  - o JCDOT, various roads: \$934,000, \$132,000 STATE-D funds
- 2025
  - JATA, purchase one vehicle: \$52,000 in STP funds and a \$13,000 local match, for a total of \$65,000
  - o JCDOT, various roads: \$1, 006,000, \$134,000 STATE-D funds
- 2026
  - JATA, purchase one vehicle: \$52,000 in STP funds and a \$13,000 local match, for a total of \$65,000
  - o JCDOT, various roads: \$1, 026,000, \$137,000 STATE-D funds

The motion was approved unanimously.

#### ITEM 7 Adjournment

Chair Kline adjourned the meeting at 11:51 AM.
