Mr. Gatz announced that R2PC will have two new planners starting on January 6th.



- <u>221341 Blackstone Street: Glick Hwy to VanBuren Street:</u> Left turn lanes being added at the intersection of Glick Hwy. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Blackstone Street will be packaged and let with the Brown Street project above. **Not confirmed for 02-07-25 letting. Therefore, 03-07-25 letting is anticipated.**

Construction:

I-94 at Elm Road, Lansing Ave. and West Ave. (US-127) reconstruction, also includes resurfacing on US-127 (I-94 to Parnall) — Clean up, turf establishment and other various items of work remain.

I-94 from M-60 to Calhoun County line – Reconstruction from M-60 to Michigan Ave, major rehabilitation from Michigan Ave to Calhoun County line – (2022-2025 construction). Work will resume with signing and project cleanup activities near January 8th depending on the weather.

Cooper Street (M-106) bridge replacement in downtown Jackson south of train station and Louis Glick (I-94BL) deck replacement near Mechanic Street – Construction on the watermain along Cooper Street is expected to begin in early January, weather permitting. This will require the closure of Cooper Street, and the posted detour will utilize Washington Ave to Louis Glick to MLK to Cooper and vice versa.

US-127 northbound ramp to Westbound I-94 – Safety project - High friction surface treatment. 2025 construction.

US-127 at Jefferson Road – Bridge repairs. 2025 construction.

M-106 over Portage River – Bridge repairs. 2025 construction.

M-50 from Brooklyn to Napoleon – Preventative maintenance - Microsurface. 2025 construction

M-50 at Clark Lake Road - Safety project - Install center left turn lane. 2025 construction.

M-99 from Village of Springport to M-50 – Preventative maintenance – Chip seal with Fog Seal. 2025 Construction

M-50 from Hopcraft to near Eaton Rapids – Preventative maintenance – Chip seal with Fog Seal. 2025 Construction
