218256 Lansing Avenue Corridor Safety Enhancements (North) & (South): Traffic signal modernization at Jackson-Ganson, Lansing-North, Lansing-Clinton and Lansing-Monroe intersections. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Contractor is Rauhorn Electric. Underground work (bases and conduits) to be completed in early April. Signal and sidewalk construction to commence in May.

- 216593 MLK Equality Trail, MLK Jr Drive to Merriman with connection to Elmdale Trail: Reconstruct trail with 12' wide concrete pavement and construct connector to Ella Sharp Park Elmdale Trail along South Street. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Merlo Construction Company, Inc. of Milford was low bidder in 03-07-25 letting (0.40% over estimate). Contract award is pending. Precon meeting will be scheduled following award. Construction to commence after award and be completed mid-November 2025.
- 218247 Losey Ave and 218249 High St and Morrell St bridges over the Grand River: Capital Preventive Maintenance work on three bridges. Consulting engineering by Great Lakes Engineering. Anlaan Corporation of Grand Haven was low bidder in 03-07-25 letting (22.28% over estimate). Contract was awarded 03-21-25. Precon meeting pending. Construction to be completed in September 2025.
- <u>220137 Morrell Street Signals at Brown and at Wisner</u>: Reconstruct signals with mast-arm mounted heads. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Rauhorn Electric is the contactor. Precon meeting was held on 03-11-25. Construction scheduled to commence after 06-23-25 (to avoid impact to schools), be open to traffic by 08-08-25 and complete in 05-29-26.
- 220138 Martin Luther King Jr. Dr.: South St to Morrell (MLK Corridor RAISE Grant): Reconstruct roadway with reduction from three lanes to two lanes with parking on both sides and multi-use path on west side. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Phase 1 (High to Morrell) will be constructed in 2025. Phase 2 (South to High) will be constructed in 2026. Bailey Excavating, Inc. of Jackson was low bidder in 03-07-25 letting (8.45% over estimate). Contract award is pending. Precon meeting will be scheduled following award.
- 221339 Brown Street: Denton Road to High Street (bundled with 221341 below): Mill and resurfacing and sidewalk ramp repairs. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Brown Street will be packaged and let with the Blackstone Street project below. Michigan Paving and Materials Company was low bidder in 03-07-25 letting (1.26% under estimate). Contract award is pending. Precon meeting will be scheduled following award. Construction to commence after 07-07-25 and be completed by 08-15-25.
- 221341 Blackstone Street: Glick Hwy to VanBuren Street (bundled with 221339 above): Left turn lanes being added at the intersection of Glick Hwy. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Blackstone Street will be packaged and let with the Brown Street project above. Scheduled for 03-07-25 letting. Construction to commence after notice to proceed and be completed by 08-15-25.

I-94 from M-60 to Calhoun County line – Reconstruction from M-60 to Michigan Ave, major rehabilitation from Michigan Ave to Calhoun County line – (2022-2025 construction). Signing and clean up work will be occurring, depending on the weather. Minor paving and bridge work will occur later this spring.

Cooper Street (M-106) bridge replacement in downtown Jackson south of train station and Louis Glick (I-94BL) deck replacement near Mechanic Street – The first phase of watermain construction is nearly complete and bridge work should begin soon.

US-127 northbound ramp to Westbound I-94 – Safety project - High friction surface treatment. <u>Work should begin in late April or May.</u>

US-127 at Jefferson Road – Bridge repairs. <u>Work should begin in mid-April. Detours will begin near</u> <u>May.</u>

M-106 over Portage River – Bridge repairs. Work scheduled to begin near July.

M-50 from Brooklyn to Napoleon – Preventative maintenance - Microsurface. <u>Work scheduled to begin</u> <u>near June</u>.

M-50 at Clark Lake Road – Safety project – Install center left turn lane. Work scheduled to begin near mid-April.

M-99 from Village of Springport to M-50 – Preventative maintenance – Chip seal with Fog Seal. <u>Work</u> <u>scheduled to begin near May.</u>

M-50 from Hopcraft to near Eaton Rapids – Preventative maintenance – Chip seal with Fog Seal. <u>Work</u> <u>scheduled to begin near May.</u>

Design:

Cooper Street (M-106) from Michigan Ave to North Street – Preventative maintenance resurfacing and sidewalk ramps. <u>2027 construction.</u>

Cooper Street (M-106) from Third Street to Chanter – Preventative maintenance resurfacing. 2026 construction.

US-127 (Henry to near Ingham Co Line) – Maintenance resurfacing and bridge repairs at Huntoon Creek, Berry Road, Grand River and Territorial Road bridges. 2026 construction.

US-127 Bridge Repairs

Liberty and Columbia Townships, Jackson County Spring - November 2025

What Is Being Done?

Starting in early spring, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be completing bridge repairs to the US-127 bridge over the Grand River at Jefferson Road, including deck patches and joint and beam repairs. Work also includes road improvements and widening. Work is expected to be completed by November.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

- Phase 1, April May: The northbound shoulder and right-turn lane will be closed during pavement widening along the northbound US-127 shoulder.
- Phase 2, June July: Both directions of
 US-127 traffic will be shifted onto the northbound shoulder/lane with temporary concrete barrier protecting the work zone during deck and superstructure patching to the southbound half of the bridge. Milling and repaving will also occur on the western leg of the intersection. The western leg of Jefferson Road will be closed and detoured.
- Phase 3, July November: Both directions of US-127 traffic will be shifted onto the southbound shoulder/lane with temporary concrete barrier protecting the work zone during deck and superstructure patching to the northbound half of the bridge. Milling and repaving will take place on the eastern leg of the intersection. The eastern leg of Jefferson Road will be closed and detoured.
