218256 Lansing Avenue Corridor Safety Enhancements (North) & (South): Traffic signal modernization at Jackson-Ganson, Lansing-North, Lansing-Clinton and Lansing-Monroe intersections. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Contractor is Rauhorn Electric. Concrete curb and ramp work is in progress. Remaining base work and pole erection will proceed in mid-August after the Fair.

- <u>216593 MLK Equality Trail, MLK Jr Drive to Merriman with connection to Elmdale Trail</u>: Reconstruct trail with 12' wide concrete pavement and construct connector to Ella Sharp Park Elmdale Trail along South Street. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Contractor is Merlo Construction Company, Inc. Construction to commence 06-02-25. Traffic control devices were delivered on 05-28-25.
- <u>218247 Losey Ave and 218249 High St and Morrell St bridges over the Grand River:</u> Capital Preventive Maintenance work on three bridges. Consulting engineering by Great Lakes Engineering. Contractor is Anlaan Corporation. **Precon meeting held 05-06-25. Construction to commence 07-07-25.**
- <u>220137 Morrell Street Signals at Brown and at Wisner</u>: Reconstruct signals with mast-arm mounted heads. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Rauhorn Electric is the contactor. Construction to commence 06-23-25.
- 220138 Martin Luther King Jr. Dr.: South St to Morrell (MLK Corridor RAISE Grant): Reconstruct roadway with reduction from three lanes to two lanes with parking on both sides and multi-use path on west side. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Contractor is Bailey Excavating. Phase 1 (High to Morrell) will be constructed in 2025. Phase 2 (South to High) will be constructed in 2026. Phase 1 construction commenced on 05-07-25. The western two-thirds of the pavement has been removed. Water main installation is in progress.
- 221339 Brown Street: Denton Road to High Street (bundled with 221341 below): Mill and resurfacing and sidewalk ramp repairs. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Contractor is Michigan Paving and Materials Company. Construction to commence after Independence Day and be completed in mid-August. Precon meeting held 04-28-25.
- 221341 Blackstone Street: Glick Hwy to VanBuren Street (bundled with 221339 above): Left turn lane addition at the intersection of Glick Hwy. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Contractor is Michigan Paving and Materials Company. Construction scheduled to commence in mid-May and be completed in mid-August. Precon meeting held 04-28-25.

216645 Ganson Street, Elm to east City Limits: Mill and resurface pavement with ramp upgrades and sidewalk and curb repairs as needed. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). NEPA review is complete and can be approved once Section 106 review is completed.

I-94 from M-60 to Calhoun County line – Reconstruction from M-60 to Michigan Ave, major rehabilitation from Michigan Ave to Calhoun County line – (2022-2025 construction). Signing and clean up work will be occurring, depending on the weather. Minor paving and bridge work is underway and will be complete near July.

Cooper Street (M-106) bridge replacement in downtown Jackson south of train station and Louis Glick (I-94BL) deck replacement near Mechanic Street – The old bridge has been demolished, and new foundations are being installed. <u>The watermain has been bored under the RR tracks</u>. <u>Additional watermain</u> and sanitary sewer work will continue in the Cooper/Michigan intersection until late July.

US-127 northbound ramp to Westbound I-94 – Safety project - High friction surface treatment. Work will occur this summer.

US-127 at Jefferson Road – Bridge repairs. <u>Shoulder work is complete, and bridge work will resume near</u> June 10th.

M-106 over Portage River – Bridge repairs. Work is scheduled to begin near July.

M-50 from Brooklyn to Napoleon – Preventative maintenance - Microsurface. Work scheduled to begin near June.

M-50 at Clark Lake Road – Safety project – Install center left turn lane. <u>Paving is scheduled to start on</u> June 2^{nd} , and the project should be completed near the beginning of July.

M-99 from Village of Springport to M-50 – Preventative maintenance – Chip seal with Fog Seal. Work is scheduled to begin near <u>mid-June</u>.

M-50 from Hopcraft to near Eaton Rapids – Preventative maintenance – Chip seal with Fog Seal. Work is scheduled to begin near <u>mid-June</u>.

Cooper Street (M-106) from Third Street to Chanter – Preventative maintenance resurfacing. 2026 construction.

US-127 (Henry to near Ingham Co Line) – Maintenance resurfacing and bridge repairs at Huntoon Creek, Berry Road, Grand River and Territorial Road bridges. 2026 construction.
