Jackson Traffic Safety Program *Grant Application Requirements*

Funding:

The Jackson Traffic Safety Program is funded by additional court costs on traffic tickets through the 12th District Court. These funds were dedicated to the Jackson Traffic Safety Program on January 1, 1993. Since that time, over \$3,000,000 has provided funding to 24 agencies that have implemented over 200 traffic safety related projects.

Grant Requirements:

The maximum grant is \$10,000 and a local match is required. For law enforcement agencies, the match is 15% of the total cost of the project. Non-law enforcement agencies are required to provide a 35% match.

Grant requests must promote traffic safety goals as stated in this brochure. Projects may include seat belt enforcement, impaired driving patrols, educational programs, etc.

Eligible agencies include:

- Law Enforcement
- Schools
- Health Departments
- Governmental Agencies
- Non-Profit Associations

Due date:

Applications are due **June 30th** for projects proposed for funding in the next fiscal year (October 1st through September 30th).
