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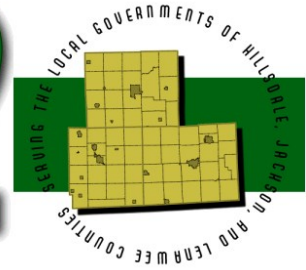

E. High Street Bridge over the Grand River - Replacement of the existing bridge superstructure. HRC is the City's consultant on this project.
