218256 Lansing Avenue Corridor Safety Enhancements (North) & (South): Traffic signal modernization at Jackson-Ganson, Lansing-North, Lansing-Clinton and Lansing-Monroe intersections. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Contractor is Rauhorn Electric. All signals are up and operating except Lansing-North. Lansing-North poles, span wires and signals will be installed when weather allows.

2025

220137 Morrell Street Signals at Brown and at Wisner: Reconstruct signals with mast-arm mounted heads. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Rauhorn Electric is the contractor. All work is substantially complete. Mast arms will be raised and signal head adjusted when weather allows.

220138 Martin Luther King Jr. Dr.: South St to Morrell (MLK Corridor RAISE Grant): Reconstruct roadway with reduction from three lanes to two lanes with parking on both sides and multi-use path on west side. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). Contractor is Bailey Excavating. Phase 1 (High to Morrell) is substantially complete. Phase 2 (South to High) will be constructed in 2026. **Phase 2 construction is scheduled to start 03-02-26.**

216645 Ganson Street, Elm to east City Limits: Mill and resurface pavement with ramp upgrades and sidewalk and curb repairs as needed. Consulting engineering by Hubble, Roth & Clark (HRC). **Contractor is Reith-Riley. Next step is to schedule a pre-con meeting.**

224332 Morrell Street, Brown to Bowen: Full-depth pavement reconstruction with ramp upgrades and sidewalk and curb repairs as needed. Bundled with 224335 below. **Professional services proposals received 02-20-26. Next step is to award professional service contract.**

224335 Morrell Street Signal at Fourth: traffic signal modernization. Bundled with 224332 above.

224847 Eastside Commerce Corridor: Project includes:

- 1) street reconstruction on Washington (Cooper to Elm)
- 2) traffic signal modernization at Elm and Page

Construction:

Cooper Street (M-106) bridge replacement in downtown Jackson south of train station and Louis Glick (I-94BL) deck replacement near Mechanic Street – Sidewalk, guardrail and turf restoration work remains at the Cooper St. bridge. The Louis Glick bridge deck replacement is scheduled to begin near April. Eastbound traffic will be detoured using Washington Ave. Westbound traffic will be maintained on Louis Glick during the project.

M-99 in the Village of Springport – Road rehabilitation and drainage improvements. Construction should begin near the end of March.

US-127 (Henry to near Ingham Co Line) – Maintenance resurfacing and bridge repairs at Grand River and Territorial Road bridges. Construction should begin near April.

M-50 from Napoleon Road to Stoney Lake Creek – Preventative Maintenance – HMA resurfacing. Work should begin near mid-June.

US-127 Southbound ramp at Springport Road – Safety project. Signal replacement. Late summer 2026 construction.

I-94 bridges over US-127/West Ave. and over the Grand River – Bridge maintenance – Epoxy overlay and seal joints. Work should begin near late June.

M-50 from M-124 to Hand Highway – Preventative maintenance resurfacing. Work should begin near mid-April.

Design:

West Ave (US-127BR/M-50) from North Street to Boardman Road – Preventative maintenance resurfacing. 2027 construction.

M-99 from Calhoun Co Line to South St. – Preventative maintenance chip seal with fog. 2027 construction.

M-124 from M-50 to US-12 – Preventative maintenance chip seal with fog. 2027 construction.

Cooper Street (M-106) from Michigan Ave to Ganson Street – Preventative maintenance resurfacing and sidewalk ramps. 2027 construction.

I-94 BL/E. Michigan Ave (Dwight to US-127) – Full reconstruction of the roadway. 2028 Construction.
